HOW TO APPLY

Submit application via email, mail, drop off or the online portal. Contact agency by phone or email at eaif@eicap.org.

REOUIREMENTS

- Be a resident of Bonneville, Clark, Fremont, Jefferson, Madison or Teton County.
- Current electric bill (with your address and account number).
- Meet the household income requirements.
- Proof of income for the last 3 months for all household members over 18 years old.
- Social Security cards for all household members.
- Completed and signed application form.

A copy of your Social Security card can be ordered online by setting up an online account at https://ssa.gov and requesting the card. (Note: You must be 18, not requesting a name change and have a driver's license or state-issued ID.)
